Geraldine re-capped on her experience of the visit – how James Heappey appeared to be genuinely interested in the proposed common and actively listened to all that was said.

Reflected on how hearing 4 local people's concerns was really helpful and will inform next steps and further engagement.

Colin raised this issue of consensus and how unrealistic it is to expect to be able to please everyone. None the less, all views are valid and we're hopeful that actually everyone wants the same thing – the field to remain a 'green space', the challenge is making sure people's fears about traffic, anti-social behaviour and succession management of the land are addressed.
