Engagement Meetings in March 2024

Residents of Eastertown and Lymsham are invited to meet with representatives of the Eastertown Evolution Community Interest Company and Steering Committee to discuss the findings of our initial surveys of public opinion regarding our proposals to purchase the land formerly owned by Dr Ann Codman in Eastertown. It is the expressed desire of the family who have inherited the estate, to offer the land for sale to the village for its preservation as a green space for the benefit of the residents.

We are presently seeking a grant from the Government Community Ownership Fund to restore an area of permanent Common land as an amenity for Lymsham village and the Eastertown hamlet.

We shall hold public meetings in the Lymsham Church on Saturday the 23rd March 2024 between 10am and 1pm, and in the Manor Hall on Wednesday the 27th March 2024 between 3:30pm and 6pm.

The information and opinions that we have gained from door-to-door enquiries, the engagement meeting held on the 20th January 2024 and the Ministerial site visit by Mr James Heappey MP on the 9th February, will be available for discussion. We have already revised our plans in response to suggestions and advice that we have received. This is a further opportunity for residents to learn about the project and we hope, add to the number of members on our steering committee.
